From South:

Take 309 North to the first traffic light in Tamaqua (Spruce Street). Turn left. Proceed up the hill and continue straight at traffic light at Hunter Street. Travel to first stop sign and turn right onto Oak Street. Travel up a steep hill to a "T" in the road. Visible ahead is the Lisa Jane Scheller Student Center. Turn right onto Van Gelder Street. The Morgan Center is the large classroom building on the left. Parking is accessible from Van Gelder and High streets.
